VENDOR BOOTHS RULES & REGULATIONS

(1) BEVERAGES:

- Soda and water will be sold **ONLY** by the City of Carrizo Springs.
(The City of Carrizo Springs reserves the right to sell all water and sodas.)
- No beverages will be sold or brought in by vendors, employees or attendees.

(2) BOOTH:

- Food Vendors ARE required to have a food handler's certification. Certificate MUST be displayed in booth.
- Only the product(s), stated on booth application, will be allowed to be represented and/or sold in the booth
- Only three (3) booths of same product will be allowed to be sold (example: 3 hamburger booths, 3 funnel cake booths, etc.)
- Booths spaces are first come first serve. Booths will be numbered.
- For **ENVIRONMENTAL** purposes all food vendors are required to provide ground cover inside their booth for the absorption of grease. No food vendor will be allowed to open for business or stay in business during the Festival if this ground cover is not in place.
- City of Carrizo Springs will provide card board on a first come first serve basis.
- Food vendors who are cooking on site must have a 5lb ABC fire extinguisher in booth.

- Water will NOT be provided. Vendors must provide their own water.
- Personal Generators are welcomed.
- The City of Carrizo Springs Inspector has the right to inspect booths to ensure ALL rules and regulations are met.

(3) COST:

- \$50.00 for 12x12 booth space. Booth space includes STANDARD electrical provisions.
- \$25.00 for each additional item sold
- Booth fee is due with application. Application deadline is June 22, 2017.

(4) SETUP: Unloading and set up of all Vendor Booths will be from:

- 6:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m. Friday, June 30, 2017, at your own risk
- 7:00 a.m. – 10:30 a.m. Saturday, July 1, 2017
- All vendor vehicles delivering and dropping off items for booths must be cleared from the loading and unloading zones by 10:30 a.m. on Saturday, July 1, 2017.
- Property left in the park overnight is at your own risk. The park will be patrolled by security. The City of Carrizo Springs will not accept liability for any damage, loss or theft of items.

(5) HOURS:

- Booths will be open for business Saturday, July 1, 2017, from 12:00 p.m. – 12:00 a.m.

(6) DEPARTURE:

- Booth representative warrants that the premises must be left in original condition as upon arrival; this includes picking up trash at and around booth area.

(8) TERMINATION RIGHTS:

- The City of Carrizo Springs reserves the right to terminate the operation of the Booth at any time during the festival for any violations of the Rules and Regulations.
